



## **My Air Cleaning and Indoor Air Quality Story**

About 20 years ago I was working for a builder doing retirement entry level homes, in the Holladay Area. One of these homes (the Bob R residence) Bob R & his family owned and operated an HVAC supply house, & filter company here in the Wasatch Front. They were very successful and donated a lot, of resources to the University of Utah, " Rice Stadium."

Back to the story Bob was checking up on his heating system installation every day, and wanted things done a certain way. He brought to the job site, by today's standards a huge humidifier, and this filter thing (pocket bag filter) that hung down like a bunch of socks hanging. After visiting with Bob and understanding how he wanted the equipment installed, and me understanding how things worked, Bob shared his story, remember Bob had access to any HVAC equipment he wanted, and owned a filter company. These bag filters were being used in clean rooms, computer component assembly rooms, and if you happen to be in the intensive care wing of your local Hospital, you would have breathed this filtered air.

Humidifiers have always been humidifiers, when we add moisture to the air it holds more heat, keeps the dust down, static electricity down & makes it easier for the filter to grab toxins in our homes.

In our visit Bob talked about when his family was younger, and how trips to the doctor were rare, unless his kids were really sick. My family was young at this time also, with kids, 3 years old to 9 years of age. My wife had the kids at the doctor every week, or at least it seemed like it. Bob promised me that the sooner I added these goodies to my home HVAC system I would be able to notice the difference. Any way I was in the business how hard would it be to Install the Bag Filter & Humidifier on my own system? The truth is the painter's home is always the last to get painted. I was sick, the kids were sick, I finally broke down, a year later & got my (Indoor Air Quality) system installed. Going to the doctor, and being sick turned off like a switch, for the whole family.

I had this system in my home in Woods Cross, and in my new home, I built in Corinne, in 1999.

My new home has tall cabin type ceilings, open areas, light fixtures in the ceiling that are hard to access & keep clean. The home, is in a pasture, with a dirt road to the home, the yard is landscaped with grass around the home. When the neighbor farmer plows his fields, and any type summer storm, we have dust bowl, brown out. Surprising enough, that even with the adverse obstacles, the inside of the home is, clean and the safe place in the dust bowls.

I'm adding to the surround variables that are also present, at our home, in Corinne. We have 300 cow dairy about ½ mile to the North of us, plus in the spring there spreading manure on all the fields around the home. We still love the rural lifestyle, no regrets. In the spring or fall when the days are comfortable we need to keep the windows closed, so we don't have the full blown odors & smells of the area.

### **"The Air Scrubber"**

This Winter the air scrubber was added to my HVAC system, Kris & I have 6 germ packers (Grand Daughters) with runny noses, grimy hands, sticky fingers, that leave paw marks everywhere. I'm afraid to touch any of them fearing I might get the sickness, that's going around in the local school system.

I have the comfort knowing that 24 hours after the visit, the germs might be cleaned up and the home safe again. No! Really we love the kids. The air scrubber has killed the scent of our electric candles, we were using to mask the outside odors, we had 5 going the air scrubber killed the candle odors. With fresh manure in the field next door, you can't stand to be in the yard, but inside the home it's fresh and clean smelling.
